Professor Peter Tyrer

Professor Peter Tyrer, Head of the Department of Psychological Medicine at Imperial College, has been appointed editor of the British Journal of Psychiatry (BJP). He has been on the Editorial Board of the Journal for 28 years, and served under four editors.

Prof. Tyrer's interests are broad, covering both clinical and research aspects of epidemiology, psychopharmacology, substance misuse, learning disability, forensic psychiatry, personality disorder and psychological treatments. He is on the editorial boards of nine other journals based in the USA, Poland, Australia, Canada and Denmark, as well as the UK, giving him a wide international perspective. Recently appeared on BBC 2 with a documentary of someone diagnosed as having personality disorder.

Satwant Singh

Mr. Singh is a nurse consultant in CBT. In April, 2003, Newham Primary Care Trust appointed him to the first ever Nursing Consultant Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) Post in the UK.

He is a fully qualified and accredited CBT therapist. He is a Registered General Nurse, Registered Mental Health Nurse, with an MSc in Mental Health Interventions and a Diploma in CT (Oxford), as well as having undertaken further training in the United States.

He has recently been a guest of Dr. Raj Persaud on BBC 4's "All in the Mind" programme, as well as a presenter at the Anxiety Disorders Conference in Manchester this past Autumn.
